2009 MERLOT

ESTATE GROWN • NAPA VALLEY

VINTAGE: For the third year in a row, Napa Valley received only two-thirds of its average rainfall in 2009, which reduced crop levels somewhat. Spring was essentially frost-free, and a relatively cool summer with no drastic heat surges brought smooth, even grape development. Just before harvest a few days of heat ensured perfect ripeness and allowed a leisurely harvest.

VINEYARD: Our cool climate Merlot comes from our vineyards in southern Napa Valley grown within sight of the San Francisco Bay. We blended in a small amount of Merlot from our warmer upper Napa Valley vineyards to craft a complex, balanced wine. Committed to natural winegrowing and sustainability, we farm our five estate vineyards without artificial fertilizers, pesticides or herbicides, and they are certified organic and Biodynamic®.

THE WINE: This is a Cabernet lovers' Merlot! Its bright strawberries, cherries, and black pepper with a velvety mouthfeel make you ask for more! The wine's firm tannins and vibrant acidity create the perfect partner with beef tenderloin, rack of lamb, or roasted pork.
