CABERNET SAUVIGNON 1990

Undoubtedly the 1990 vintage will be remembered as one of the best since 1985. This special offering from Grgich Hills Cellar is rich, deep, supple and complex. Like our 1985 Cabernet, balance and harmony are two outstanding attributes of this wine. The dark, brooding, purple-red color leads to a spicy aroma with mouth-filling flavors of ripe, berry fruit and a counterpoint of sweet oak.

Good acid and soft tannins contributed to the basic structure of this wine. Blended with 2% Merlot and 2% Cabernet Franc for additional complexity, this 1990 Cabernet spent two years in premium French and American oak barrels followed by two additional years of bottle aging.
